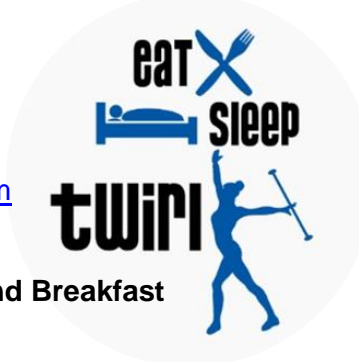

General Information

1. Baker University and contest directors will **NOT** be responsible for accidents or lost items. Release must be signed by each participant.
2. 2019 **NBTA** rules will be in effect. **NBTA** judging staff decisions are final.
3. Competition age is determined by the twirler's age on 9/1/18.
4. Individual contestants will perform in reverse order as the entries are received.
5. No flash photography. Video only your own daughter, student, or group.
6. Concession stand will be open. No outside food will be permitted in the facility. We appreciate your support of the concession stand.
7. No food or drink in the dressing area or gym.
8. Facility fee is \$15.00 per contestant (\$10 for early entries). Those competing in teams only will not pay the facility fee. Please be respectful of the facility so we will be allowed to use this location again.
9. **No refunds.** No entries accepted without money order. No phone entries. Money orders must be made to Kande Sell.
10. Team prince and princess will have an interview, compete in basic strut, and 30 seconds of their team routine. They perform in team costume. Multiple entries per team permitted.

20% Modeling in strut or solo costume

40% Basic Strut

40% Solo

Team Prince/Princess

Following a salute, execute a basic strut square to standard march music wearing a team uniform.

Perform 30 sec. maximum of a routine reflecting your position in the team (i.e. twirlers twirl,

dancers dance, pom member executes pom routine).

Contestant must also complete an interview.

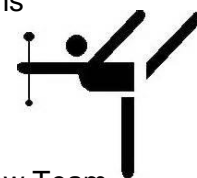

Dance Solo, Duets, and Trios

Duets and Trios will be offered for \$15.00 per competitor. Write these events in on your entry if you choose to participate. These are not considered group events and the processing fee will apply. Competitors will receive a I, II or III rating and appropriate award.

No tap, acrobatic, or gymnastics allowed. Time limit is 2-3 minutes with music of your choice. Dance teams may enter as danceline or for ratings
